I have been an Anglican since birth, growing up in Sydney. After school, I spent most of the next 20 years in Canberra-Goulburn Diocese, except for four years overseas studying for a Masters in Christian Studies at Regent College (Vancouver) and a PhD at Vrije Universiteit (Amsterdam), in Biblical Hebrew linguistics. I was ordained to the priesthood in 2009 and in 2010 moved to Adelaide to be Principal of St Barnabas Theological College (2010-2017).

In September 2022 I took up the position of priest-in-charge at St Theodore's, Toorak Gardens. Liz and I (and our three adult children when they're home) love living here.

I have always loved parish ministry and academic scholarship, and I remain active in both areas. In ministry, I enjoy preaching and pastoral work, and have preached at the National Anglican Deacons Conference; the National Anglican Bishops Conference; the Willochra and Adelaide Synods; the Willochra, Adelaide, Ballarat, and Canberra-Goulburn Clergy Conferences; General Synod; and the National Anglican Deans Conference.

I have been on General Synod since 2017 and am actively engaged with Anglicans from around the country in the promotion of an inclusive, comprehensive, and open-hearted Anglicanism. I was delighted to contribute three chapters to "Marriage, Same-sex Marriage and the Anglican Church of Australia: Essays from the Doctrine Commission", 2019, on "Scripture and Moral Reasoning", "An Alternative Reading of the BCP", and "The Case for Same-Sex Marriage".

In academia, I am a lecturer/honorary research fellow at the University of Divinity and Charles Sturt University. I founded the Biblical Hebrew Language and Linguistics Unit, Society of Biblical Literature (International), and am a member of the Society of Biblical Literature and the National Association of Professors of Hebrew (USA). I am a trustee of the Australian Research Theological Foundation Incorporated (ARTFinc).

Since 2022 I have been working on a new liturgical translation of the Psalms for the Anglican Church of Australia ([www.ansteypsalter.com](http://www.ansteypsalter.com)). The first trial was held in June-July 2025 and the project is expected to take another 5-6 years.

Outside work, I am a Level 3 Match Official with Football South Australia, spending most weekends refereeing mens and womens soccer. I am also the FSA Community Referee Welfare Officer, providing support to referees who have faced abuse and other such challenges during games.

I currently serve as Rector of Christ Church North Adelaide. This role has given me significant governance experience, including responsibility for board operations, compliance with the ACNC Act and the Work Health & Safety Act, and oversight of finances and assets. I work with the Select Vestry, auditors, and investment advisers to ensure accountability, transparency, and long-term sustainability. I have also served on the CMS-SA/NT General Committee and as President of the St Andrew's School Past Students Association. Since 2024, I have been a member of the Diocesan Council, contributing to diocesan governance and mission strategy.

Christ Church North Adelaide holds substantial resources and property for which I am responsible. In a previous parish, I oversaw the construction of a new parish hall and successfully managed the funding arrangements. These experiences have given me a practical understanding of financial oversight and asset management.

Risk management has also been a consistent part of my leadership. I have implemented WHS policies in several parishes, embedding a culture of safety and accountability. I currently serve as Chair of the Diocesan Domestic & Family Violence Working Group, appointed by the Archbishop. This group is responsible for implementing the Ten Commitments for Preventing and Responding to Domestic and Family Violence, helping to create safer and healthier communities across the Diocese.

Communication is central to my ministry. I use newsletters, personal conversations, livestreaming, and social media to engage with diverse audiences. At Christ Church North Adelaide, digital strategies have helped us connect with new generations. I also helped establish the Welcome Salisbury initiative, which supported more than 250 refugees, including arrivals from Manus Island. The program provided English classes, meals, and advocacy, and deepened my commitment to listening to and standing alongside vulnerable people.

I remain attentive to legal and regulatory issues through my membership of Christian Ministry Advancement Ltd (CMA), which provides training and updates in governance and compliance.

Leadership and people management have been integral to my work. I have led staff teams in every parish I have served, including supervising over ten staff at Christ Church North Adelaide. I seek to lead collaboratively, with accountability and care, building positive cultures where teams can serve with confidence and joy.

Strategic mission planning has been at the heart of my ministry. I have introduced Messy Church in several parishes, overseen contemporary services, and developed innovative models to connect with younger families and new communities. These experiences demonstrate my desire to hold mission and governance together, ensuring our decisions serve both faithfulness and growth.

With nearly 17 years of ordained ministry, I bring experience in governance, finance, risk, compliance, communication, leadership, and mission. I am committed to transparent, collaborative, and faithful governance that supports the flourishing of our Diocese and the communities we serve.

After undergraduate studies in Commerce, Law, Management, and Computer Science, I felt God's calling to study theology at the Adelaide College of Divinity. I graduated with a *Bachelor of Theology* in 2019, and (God willing) will graduate my *Master of Theological Studies* through St Barnabas College in February 2026.

I had a 10 year career in the IT sector, part of that time in consultancy and management roles. My last IT roles were in Anglicare SA's IT team. Since 2021 I have worked in Anglicare's Mission & Anglican Community Engagement team, and I became the Manager of this team in 2023.

Currently, they are not directly represented in our governance structures and so they have Anglican identity but no direct agency within the church's representation (taxation without representation, in effect).

I am married to Stephanie (a teacher and a fellow theology graduate), and we are both committed to working for a healthy, spiritually safe and mature church that will nurture our two boys and future generations.

Our Diocesan Vision was developed consultatively, is theologically grounded, and sets the right ideals for us to live into. I hope we can continue to embrace its call upon us, as we seek to be "Adelaide Anglicans, Flourishing & United in God's Love".

I became skilled in managing conflict while maintaining relationships and allowing everyone to feel that their point of view had been heard and valued.

As a leader within the Department for Education, I worked within the policy and procedure frameworks provided, ensuring that all children, young people, their families and staff understood the reasons behind changes, assisting them to manage alterations to school life that challenged some. My career involved:

- regular professional learning
- Running recruitment panels to assess applicants for a range of positions, using merit selection processes to ensure a fair process
- Supporting staff involved in disciplinary processes; keeping the welfare and wellbeing of children young people and staff uppermost in deliberations at all times.

I've served in the Anglican community since baptism – where I imagine my vocal cry as holy water splashed in my eye was my active agreement to be involved in church. My baby self living through milestones then gaining different life experiences meant I was going to be a witness for groups ostracised from certain groupings. In my case, I grew up on the “wrong” side of Apartheid. Chinese born South African meant our group was segregated or classified Black, Coloured or Mixed-Coloured. In 1987 I was the first non-white in a white bilingual school, at this young age I was able to see the other side of this man-made segregation policy.

I've also seen women being ordained to the priesthood, choir boys turning into non-gender or age-specific choirs, I've also seen churches adapt under economic strain. There was a stage where in a democratic South Africa, I wasn't Black enough for Black Empowerment Equity Policies, but a rectification in the Constitutional Court meant a recognition for the Chinese-born South Africans.

I've been a testament of God working outside of the usual, even now, my latest table includes 'migrant', not just a word but an experience of adopting a new country on country. Learning about treaty and reconciliation in Australia, and bringing my own lived experience from the days of the Truth and Reconciliation Commission in South Africa, and the 30 years of democracy South Africans have learnt to amend their hearts to.

I currently serve as Assistant to the Parish Priest and Parish Council (APP) at the Parish of Stirling, bringing a love of technology to help streamline processes. While not always “with it” on the latest platforms, I bridge the perspectives of my own generation, the younger ones, and the legacy of those before us. Holding space for diverse ideas and including them in conversation.

When I asked my nominator “Why me?”, she kindly pointed out I clearly have a passion for people and the church. That moved me to continue standing for nomination.

As a layperson, I serve the church through roles such as former People's Warden, currently as APP, Lay Reader, and Sacristan. With recently received Graduate Certificate in Leadership from the University of Divinity, I bring these experiences together to help shape conversations about our denomination's future and how we live out our Anglican faith along with the wider church with grace, peace, hope, joy, and love.

I am standing for the Bishops Nomination Committee because I believe I have the kind of experience, understanding, and perspective, that would make a helpful contribution in the selection of candidates for the role of Archbishop, if a new BNC is required.

First, in terms of experience, I have been working in ordained Anglican ministry in Adelaide for 25 years and in that time I have been involved in the extensive and lasting revitalisation and growth of three parishes: St Matthew's Kensington (5 years), St Bartholomew's Norwood (11 years), and Henley-Grange (10 years).

Second, in terms of understanding, I believe that I could bring to the Bishops Nomination Committee a comprehension of what it is that enables parishes to be turned around from patterns of decline into new patterns of health, vitality and growth.

In my view, all else that we might love and long for depends on this primary need being met. I love the Anglican church deeply, with its rich heritage of theology and practice that I could not find equalled elsewhere. By conviction and tradition, I am evangelical, which at its heart means loving Jesus Christ and his gospel and being earnest in his mission in the world. I have given most of my adult life to serving the diocese of Adelaide with a vision for its renewal and its advancement for the sake of this city that I love. I think that someone of my tradition, who has also worked in an Anglo Catholic setting, has a helpful contribution to make in the deliberations of the BNC and could act as voice for the concerns of people in the diocese.

I believe that the next Bishops Nomination Committee, should it be required, needs to reflect the composition of the diocese and be genuinely representative of the diversity in this diocese to help us find candidates who could serve the full range of the Anglican church in Adelaide and relate effectively to all its people.

I believe that with my knowledge and love of the diocese of Adelaide, with significant experience in the challenges of parish ministry, with an understanding of kind of candidates we need, and with a helpful perspective to offer, I could play a positive role in the Bishops Nomination Committee.
