Subject:	Stipends and allowances from first pay period in January 2026

Diocesan Council has resolved pursuant to the Stipends Ordinance 1980 that the base stipend for clergy in the Diocese of Adelaide for 2026 will be **\$71,608** per annum. The rate of superannuation remains at 18% (now **\$12,889p.a.**), and the Long Service Leave contribution for 2026 will be **\$1,812**.

Parishes will continue to provide the travel allowance, and costs associated with Rectory energy and utilities in accordance with the Parochial Administration Ordinance Section 29(a).

Below is a table outlining the Base Stipend for Clergy and Deacons, please note that the Base Stipend are minimum figures only.

Stipend may be increased to recognise experience and responsibility

* NB – The stipend for Deacons is in alignment with the minimum stipend.

Long Service Leave

Long Service leave for clergy is paid in accordance with the annual Notional Stipend rate approved by the Standing Committee of the General Synod of the Anglican Church of Australia. Pursuant to Sections 28(a) & (b) of the Long Service Leave Canon 2010, the annual contribution will be \$1,812 effective from 1 January 2026.

Allowances

The following allowances are required to be provided to clergy receiving a stipend. Allowances are paid on a pro-rata basis for clergy who are fractionally stipended.

Housing Allowance

Where a house is not provided as part of a stipended clergy role that the allowance paid in lieu be 100% of any housing allowance approved by Diocesan Council from time to time. Where a clergy house is provided and clergy elects not to occupy it with the approval of the Archbishop, the allowance remains at 75% of any housing allowance approved by Diocesan Council from time to time.

In order to take into account the increase in median rents, a **Housing Allowance \$35,391 p.a.** will be paid where no Rectory is provided, and **\$26,543 p.a.** will be paid where clergy have elected not to live in the housing provided. This figure is 75% of the current median rental cost of a house in the Adelaide metropolitan area.

Utilities & Communications

Utilities and communications costs are to be paid by the parish or as negotiated.

For clergy not living in provided housing, the minimum annual allowance is **\$3,287 p.a.**

Travel

The Travel Allowance is comprised of a standing rate plus a per-kilometre re-imbusement.

The **travel allowance will remain at \$9,504p.a. plus \$0.43 per km** for vehicles used in parish work.

All these rates are effective the first pay period in 2026.

Recommended Supply Fees

The minimum supply fees are:

All locums are to be paid full stipend at the approved relevant FTE fraction. In addition, the following contributions / allowances are applied:
